A Fellow of IAB can Nominate only one architect in each cycle. Nominations, in the form of letters by at least 2 IAB Fellows (either jointly or separately) addressed to the IAB President, must reach IAB at the email **president@iab.com.bd** with a cc to **directoriabawards@gmail.com** not later than 9:00 pm on **Friday, 08 December 2023.**

At the time of nomination, the nominee must be a Fellow of IAB, and must not have received the award previously. But for the posthumous award, the nominee may not have to be a Fellow of IAB. A nominee who had been nominated but not awarded the Gold Medal in a particular cycle may be re-nominated in subsequent cycles. Each nomination must include the name and the career biography of the nominee, including evidence of the nominee's works in accordance with the selection criteria, with the consent by of the Nominee.

IAB Gold Medal 2023 is expected to be presented at a ceremony with an Address by the Gold Medalist.
