

### **GRAFTON ARCHITECTS WINS PRITZKER PRIZE 2020**

Yvonne Farrell and Shelley McNamara are the 2020 laureates for the Pritzker Architecture Prize. The pair are co-founders of Grafton Architects, according to the Pritzker Architecture were awarded for, "their integrity in their approach to both their buildings, as well as the way they conduct their practice,"

**Yvonne Farrell and Shelley** McNamara met in college at the School of Architecture at University College Dublin (UCD). After graduating, both were offered the opportunity to teach at UCD, they continued to do so until 2008. According to Farrel, "Teaching for us has always been a parallel reality," In 1978, the pair, along with three others, established Grafton Architects. Their noteworthy projects include North King Street Housing in Dublin, Ireland (2000); Urban Insitute of Ireland; University College Dublin (2002); Solstice Arts Centre in Navan, Ireland (2007); Loreto Community School in Milford, Ireland (2006); Offices for the Department of Finance in Dublin, Ireland (2009); and Medical School, University of Limerick in Limerick, Ireland (2012). They have taught at institutions including École Polytechnique Fédérale de Lausanne and Accademia di Architettura di Mendrisio and have lectured internationally. The pair have previously held the Kenzo Tange Chair at the Harvard Graduate School of Design (2010) and the Louis Kahn chair at Yale University (2011). Yvonne Farrell and Shelley McNamara were awarded the Pritzker for the way they run their studio and for their generosity towards their colleagues.

The Pritzker Architecture Prize is awarded annually by the Hyatt Foundation, funded by the Pritzker Family. The Pritzker Prize often called the Nobel Prize for architecture, is the top prize in architecture. Possible winners are selected by Executive Director, Martha Thorne who asks past winners, academics, critics, and others involved in architecture. Any licensed architect can apply for the prize before the 1st of November each year. Winners of the Prize include, inaugural laureate, Philip Johnson was awarded "for 50 years of imagination and vitality shown by the many museums, theaters, libraries, houses, gardens, and corporate structures.", 2004 laureate Zaha Hadid, being the first female prize winner, and Ryūe Nishizawa, the youngest winner in 2010 at the age of 44.

The official ceremony granting the award takes place every year, usually in May, in an architecturally significant site anywhere in the world. The event is invitation-only and is attended by international guests and quests from the host country. The laureates receive \$100,000 and a bronze medallion, based on designs of Louis Sullivan, famed Chicago architect generally acknowledged as the father of the skyscraper. On one side is the name of the prize and on the other are the words "firmness, commodity and delight", recalling Roman architect; Vitruvius' fundamental principles of architecture, "firmitas, utilitas, venustas."



# CELEBRATION OF AGA KHAN AWARD 2019 FOR ARCHITECT SAIF UL HAQUE & HIS TEAM

Bangladeshi Architect Saif Ul Haque (H-040) won the prestigious Aga Khan Award for Architecture for his outstanding project titled "Arcadia Education Project" in South Kanarchor, Keraniganj. Ar. Saif Ul Haque is the principal of the architectural practice Saif Ul Haque Sthapati and the Director of Research & Design Program, Bengal Institute for Architecture, Landscape and Settlements. # OPEN DISCUSSION ON THE ISSUES ARISING DURING THE PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF DESIGNS FOR RAJUK APPROVAL IN THE LIGHT OF BUILDING CONSTRUCTION RULES AND POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS

An open discussion was held at Berger Seminar Hall of IAB Centre on 11 January 2020 (Saturday) at 4:30 pm on the issues arising during the preparation and submission of designs for RAJUK approval in the light of building construction rules and possible solutions. Ar. Nowajish Mahbub, General Secretary, IAB chaired the meeting. Besides, on behalf of the Institute, Ar. Jalal Ahmed, President, and Ar. Mamnoon Murshed Chowdhury, Vice President (National Affairs) addressed the meeting.

Numerous architects including Ar. Mahmudul Aziz (A-109), Ar. Manzur Elahi (A-222), Ar. Mehedi Amin (A-174), Ar. Abdul Halim (A-233), Ar. Pradyut Basak (E-08), Ar. Syed Sirajul Haque (H-034) made their statements. In addition, various issues were sent through e-mail by other architects, including Ar. Nasima Islam (I-059), was also discussed.

Several issues were addressed in the discussion, such as the lack of coordination between the Civil Aviation Authority and RAJUK in design approval, the illegal bond system at RAJUK, various harassing activities against architects due to the forgery of signatures by others, the illegal construction of different parts of the building by the owner after the supervision period. Other complaints, including misleading RAJUK explanations of the front balcony, side balcony, hanging veranda, were discussed.

Some of the suggestions made by the architects include holding regular meetings with the authorized RAJUK officers concerned, involving the members of the BC Committee in the CPD or seminar activities on construction rules, the mandatory submission of photographs of the constructed building during the application of the occupancy certificate by the building owner, and monitor the construction of buildings to stop illegal construction.

At the end of the meeting, the

IAB President drew everyone's attention and said that the problems would be resolved to a large extent with the new method that would be implemented for the formulation and approval of the design at RAJUK. He stated that the IAB would act against the architects involved in the forgery of the signature and that RAJUK would also be asked to take action against the RAJUK officers/employees involved in the forgery of the signature. All the architects present at the meeting were also assured that all the complaints received had been duly documented and that all necessary steps would be taken to resolve them.



# AWARD GIVING CEREMONY OF KSRM AWARDS FOR FUTURE ARCHITECTS BEST UNDERGRADUATE THESIS

The much-awaited award-giving ceremony of 'KSRM AWARDS FOR FUTURE ARCHITECTS for Best Undergraduate Thesis, in association with IAB' was held on Wednesday, January 8, 2020 at Hotel Intercontinental Dhaka. This was the very first award ceremony of this newly introduced Student Award for the Award cycle 2018-19. This award is a forum that brings together under one roof all three Architecture domains -Academia, Industry, and Profession.

Mr. S M Rezaul Karim MP, Honorable Minister, Minister of Housing and Public Works and Mr. Mohibul Hasan Chowdhury MP, Honorable Deputy Minister, Ministry of Education of Govt. of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, Shahriar Jahan, DMD, KSRM Steel Plant Ltd, Ar. Jalal Ahmed, President, IAB were present on the occasion and awarded the crests, certificates, and cheques to the winners. Along with the students, their thesis teachers and respective architecture department too received recognition on their achievements.

KSRM as a representative of the Building Industry has come forward to recognize the talents of graduating architecture students by getting associated with IAB in making this proposal from IAB a reality. This collaboration would not have been possible without their support. This will be an annual award program for graduating Architecture students henceforth and play a vital role hopefully in bridging the existing gap between academia, industry, and profession gradually.

A total of 28 projects from 10 IAB accredited architecture schools of the country were submitted. These projects had already gone through an internal screening at their respective schools and then only found their way to IAB to be included in the national level of evaluation. A panel of eminent jurors Ar. Mohammad Ali Naqi [Vice-chancellor of Stamford University Bangladesh], Dr. Fuad H Mallick [Professor and Dean, School of Design, BRAC University], Dr. Farida Nilufar [Professor of Architecture at BUET], Ar. Saif Ul Hague [Aga Khan award 2019 winner and Director Research and Design program, Bengal Institute for Architecture, Landscape and Settlement] and Ar. Mustafa Ameen [Principle and Proprietor of Domus Architects] evaluated these projects.

All the entries were then publicly displayed in a three-day-long Exhibition from December 25 to December 27, 2019 at IAB Centre which was open for all. On the eve of the award giving ceremony a booklet was published containing all the submitted projects with jury citations.

# LANDMARK MONUMENT: CELEBRATING 100 YEARS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF DHAKA AND GOLDEN JUBILEE OF INDEPENDENCE OF BANGLADESH AT UNIVERSITY OF DHAKA

### OPEN ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN COMPETITION | 56 ENTRIES | BEST 03 IN BRIEF

An open architectural design competition was launched on 04 January 2020, for a "Landmark Monument" to mark the Centenary of the University of Dhaka and the Golden Jubilee of the Independence of Bangladesh at Mall Area, a very intriguing parcel in the campus of the University of Dhaka. The university has a keen interest in this momentous project and has allocated development funds in favor of the "construction of Landmark Monument: Celebrating 100 Years of the University of Dhaka and Golden Jubilee of Independence of Bangladesh" at the mall area. The spot was earlier selected to construct "Kendrio Shahid Minar" by then Vice-Chancellor Professor Dr. Muzaffar Ahmed Chaudhury in 1972. The Landmark Monument will represent the university over its 100 years journey incorporating knowledge and our

glorious struggle for freedom.

Institute of Architects Bangladesh in association with the University of Dhaka, organized the competition in commemoration of these two colossal events together. The objectives of the competition assignment were:

a. To create a minimalistic, iconic, and instant image that represents the University of Dhaka for generating new and integrating knowledge, revolution, Liberalism, Democratic values. Secularism. Unity and Sacrifice over its 100 years period of existence. b. To uphold the contribution of the University of Dhaka during the period of language movement in 1952, mass upsurge in 1969, and our Liberation War to pave the path of independent Bangladesh. c. To consider the Mall area as

"Muktijodhdha Chattar" with necessary/befitting landscape to be done along with the "Landmark Monument" proposal.

The last date of submission of the proposals was 11 March 2020 at IAB Centre. A total of 56 entrants submitted their design proposals in widespread enthusiasm. The Jury convened on 13-14 March 2020 at the same venue. The jury was comprised of Prof. Nisar Hossain (Dean, Faculty of Fine Arts, University of Dhaka), Prof. Shibli Rubayat Islam (Dean, Faculty of Business Studies, University of Dhaka), Ar. Nahas Ahmed Khalil (ARC Architectural Consultants), Ar. Khan Md. Mustapha Khalid (Vistara Architects Pvt Ltd.) and Ar. Marina Tabassum (MTA).

The result announcement was dated 14 March 2020. All submitted entries were open for

exhibition on 15, 16 & 18 March 2020 at IAB Centre. The competition was directed by Ar. Sheikh Itmam Soud, Secretary-Publication and Publicity, IAB with the valuable support of the deputy director Ar. Sakib Ahsan Choudhury. The whole competition was coordinated by Ar. Bayejid Mahbub Khondker, Secretary-Profession, 23rd EC, IAB.























PLAN SCALE - 1:250

" The jury found the paradoxical relationship of the two atmospheres intriguing. The design successfully captured monumentality of a landmark yet maintaining the scale befitting to an educational institution."

# **CPD ON MEANS OF EGRESS IN TERMS OF LIFE SAFETY**

IAB believes that proper teaching and training on fire safety and its practical implementation in the field of architecture will help architects in improving fire safety conditions in buildings designed by them. For such, IAB periodically organizes workshops on topics like fire safety, building rules and regulations, etc.

The Continuing Professional Development Workshop on the topic 'Means of Egress in Terms of Life Safety' was organized by the Institute of Architects Bangladesh on 26 February 2020 at the Berger Seminar Hall of IAB Centre. The first CPD on the same topic was held on 30 January 2020 at the same place. Ar. Dewan Shamsul Arif conducted the three and half hour long workshops and Secretary Profession of 23rd Executive Council, IAB Ar. Bayejid Mahbub Khondker coordinated the events.

The first session of the workshop was focused on the classification of buildings according to Bangladesh National Building Code (BNBC) 2006. The detailed overviews to understand the Classification of Buildings based on Occupancy, Occupancy Separation Rating, Fire Zone, and Building Construction Types based on Fire Resistance discussed comprehensively. After that to achieve minimum requirements for life safety, one of the major items "Means Of Egress" was discussed in detail which includes its fire rating, number of exits, placements, capacity, and all of its necessary components.

Certificates were distributed among all the participants at the completion of the program.



# **CPD ON CODE OF ETHICS AND PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT 2018**

Architectural practice is constantly impacted by the evolving socio-economic conditions. An architect in practice, when interacting with persons within or outside the profession, often faces a dilemma about the ethical implications of his/her decisions, as in many situations, what is lawful may not necessarily be ethical. In recent times, with the advent of social media, such issues have become more complex and are debated widely.

Keeping this in view, the Institute

of Architects Bangladesh formulated the Code of Ethics & Professional Conduct in 2010. It was updated in 2018. To make architects aware of the ethical obligations of architects' practice, IAB has initiated a CPD program where members are made aware of the premises and details of the codes. On 23 January 2020, such an event was organized at IAB Centre and it was participated by 40 members. Ar. Mamnoon Murshed Chowdhury, Vice President (National Affairs), IAB conducted the three-hour-long

workshop and Ar. Bayejid Mahbub Khondker, Secretary Profession of 23rd Executive Council, IAB coordinated the event.

The first session of the workshop focused on the 2010 edition of the Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct and was briefly discussed on the 2018 version of the new inclusions. Certificates were distributed among all the participants at the completion of the CPD program.

Moreover, IAB also took additional initiatives to involve its members in proposing potential heritage sites for the World Heritage Tentative List.

It may be mentioned that, in Bangladesh, there are only two World Heritage sites (Cultural) -Historic Mosque City of Bagerhat and The Ruins of the Buddhist Vihara at Paharpur, which were included in 1985.

Ar. Sujaul Islam Khan prepared the nomination document for 'National Assembly Complex, Bangladesh' with the advice of Ar. Dr. Kazi Khaleed Ashraf. Ar. Muhtadin Iqbal and Ar. Md. Wahiduzzaman Ratul was entrusted to prepare the nomination document for 'The Architectural Work of Muzharul Islam- an Outstanding Contribution to the Modern Movement in South Asia.' with the advice of Ar. Saif Ul Haque. Ar. Fatema Tasmia prepared the nomination document for 'The Architectural Work of Architect Robert G. Boughey, A Pioneering Contribution in the History of Modern Architecture in Bangladesh'. Moreover, Ar. Jalal Ahmed, President, IAB, Ar. Dr.

Abu Sayeed M Ahmed, Past President, IAB; Ar. Dr. Sharif Shams Imon, President, ICOMOS-BD, and Ar. Mohammad Sazzad Hossain, Secretary, Heritage & Culture, IAB contributed with their suggestions, opinions, and guidelines in preparing the Nomination-documents. On 27 January 2020, a meeting was also held at IAB Centre to discuss the aforementioned proposals.

Ar. Jalal Ahmed, President, IAB and Ar. Mohammad Sazzad Hossain, Secretary, Heritage & Culture, IAB coordinated the teamwork and took the necessary steps to send the proposals. On 15 February 2020, IAB officially sent the following proposals for inclusion in the World Heritage Tentative List: 1. National Assembly Complex, Bangladesh

 2. The Architectural Work of Muzharul Islam- an Outstanding Contribution to the Modern Movement in South Asia.
3. The Architectural Work of Architect Robert G. Boughey- A Pioneering Contribution in the History of Modern Architecture in Bangladesh.

It may be mentioned that modern heritage has already ensured a significant position at the world heritage list. Bangladesh has a very rich modern heritage that needs to be focused in a global context. IAB-proposals to include the modern heritage of Bangladesh in the world heritage tentative list will ensure a strong step to open a new window to promote the Architecture of Bangladesh in a global context.


