



#### NOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK



#### REMEMBERING AN ARCHITECT AND A POET

Rabiul Husain an architect, poet, artist and a cultural activist was born in 1943.

When he used to meet me, he often told me that since he could draw very well, his high school friend late Dr. Fazle Rabbi a mechanical engineer, who also happens to be my maternal uncle, inspired him to study architecture at the newly established architecture department of the then only technical university EPUET (now BUET) of the erstwhile East Pakistan. He lost his father at the early age. Since he was the eldest son, he had to shoulder the responsibility of the family and took a part-time job as a student to meet the educational expenses of all his nine siblings. He began his architecture career as a student at Vastukalabid, the practice of the late maestro Ar. Muzharul Islam. When Muzharul Islam joined the liberation war and went to India, in his absence, Ar. Rabiul Husain and Prof. Shamsul Wares were managing some of Islam's major projects. As a young student and a cultural activist, he initiated a radical journal called "Na" meaning "No" as a protest against the societal, cultural and political norms. After the liberation of the country, Ar. Rabiul with few other architect friends started an architectural practice named "Grihakantipit". Later in 1975. He joined Shaheedullah and Associates Ltd. as a director. He continued as a director of the Shaheedullah and Associates Ltd till his death.

In 1987, he wrote a book on architecture titled "Bangladesher Sthapatya Shongskriti" meaning "Architecture Culture of Bangladesh". This was probably the first book on vernacular architecture of the country written in Bangla by a
Bangladeshi architect. He was
also one of the founders and an
active member of the
architecture movement called
"CHETANA" meaning
consciousness.

Among his notable architectural works are "Bangladesh Agricultural Research Council" or BARC Building and "Khamar Bari" complex" at Farmgate, Dhaka and numerous buildings under the ministry of agriculture and the ministry of education all across Bangladesh, including the polytechnic institutes in Khulna and Chittagong. One of his recent favorite projects was a small visitor interpretation center on a killing field of the Liberation War at Mirpur, Dhaka. Last year, he took me to show this project and I found him to be very much emotionally attached with it.

He was fondly known as Robi da or brother Robi to many of us and also in the cultural field. For is amiable and warm personality, he had many friends and followers across Bangladesh, as well in many other countries. He was a founder and the President of IAB for four times, President of SAARCH, Vice-Chairman of ARCASIA and the CAA.

He received the Berger Lifetime Achievement Awards in 2013 and IAB Gold Medal in 2016 for his outstanding contribution in the field of architecture. Along with architecture, he was equally active in the cultural arena of the country. He was the President of the national poets' guild "Jatiyo Kabita Parishad" and one of the initiator of the National Poetry Festival. He received the "Ekushey Padak" in 2018 and the "Bangla Academy Awards" in 2009 for his poetry and literature. He was involved in many organizations. Notable among them, he was one of the trustees of the "Bangabandhu Memorial Trust" and the "Liberation War Museum".

Rabiul Husain breathed his last in a hospital in Dhaka on 26 November, 2019 and left behind his only son Robin, siblings, many friends and well-wishers.

After late Sthapatyacharja Muzharul Islam, Rabiul Husain was the lighthouse for all of us who played a pivotal role in the development of the Institute of Architects Bangladesh (IAB). His untimely demise is an irreparable loss for the architecture as well as the cultural community of the country. Before burial, Honorable Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina came to pay her last respect to him. A condolence book was opened at IAB and his dead body was brought to IAB Centre for the members to pay their last respect. He was finally laid to rest at the Martyred Intellectuals Graveyard, Mirpur.

On 16th December, 2019, IAB organized a condolence meet to pay tribute to this eminent architect, poet, artist and cultural activist, which was attended by architects, eminent cultural personalities, friends and family. Liberation War Museum and Jatiyo Kobita Parishad also organized separate condolence meets in his remembrance.

The only solace we have is that Ar. Rabiul Husain could attend the ARCASIA Forum 20, and the ARCASIA 50 Years celebration, where he could meet many of his old architect friends from across the continent for the last time.

#### **ARCASIA FORUM 20**

This ARCASIA Forum 20 was the largest international event ever organized by IAB. The participation and enthusiasm of the members and students in the series of events exceeded expectations.

In addition to the standard ARCASIA events like the Forum/Congress, Council meeting, the Committee meetings, the AAA and the Friendship Night, following were the highlights of the eventful 6 days:

- More than 1600 local and international architects/delegates attended the ARCASIA Forum 20;
- 14 local and international speakers including 6 keynote speakers made their presentations in the Forum 20;
- 20 papers were presented in the Forum 20;
- Around 700 students attended the presentations of the AAA winners;
- Speaker of the National Parliament, 4 Ministers and the Mayor of Dhaka North City Corporation attended different programs of ARCASIA;
- 4 exhibitions on architecture were held at the Forum 20 venue of BICC;

- 3 public exhibitions on architecture were held at different locations of the city;
- 6 different publications and a newspaper supplement were published;
- Students of 9 architecture schools designed and put up installations at different locations of the city;
- City-wide branding of IAB and ARCASIA during the 6 days of ARCASIA programs;
- Huge coverage of all the events in the print, electronic and social media.

Other two historic events held at Dhaka were:

- ARCASIA 50 Years Celebration with the participation of most of the past presidents/ chairpersons of ARCASIA and the 1600 architects from across
- First ever **ARCASIA Youth Forum** was held at IAB Centre.

We are also immensely happy about the following additional achievements:

- Naming of the road in front of IAB as "Sthapatyacharja Muzharul Islam Sarani" was along cherished demand of the architect's community and a rare tribute to the maestro;
- IAB candidate Ar. Dr. Abu
  Sayeed M Ahmed getting elected
  as the next President of
  ARCASIA. Heartiest
  congratulations to Ar. Abu
  Sayeed.

A grand building material expo was held after a long time by IAB. This expo has been rebranded as IAB Build-Expo 2019, as an annual event to connect the building industry with the architects.

All these have been possible due to the untiring works of more than 200 IAB members, 121 students who volunteered to make all these happen. The 23rd Executive Council is ever grateful to all of them for their selfless service to IAB.

IAB would like to gratefully acknowledge the generous support of all the sponsors of the program. Without their support it wouldn't have been possible for IAB to undertake such a challenging program.


### A TRIBUTE TO AR. RABIUL HUSAIN APON ALOY UDVASITO JIBON

### A GRAND HOSTING OF PRESTIGIOUS ARCASIA FORUM 20 BY IAB AT DHAKA 2-7 NOVEMBER 2019

2019 was a special year for ARCASIA. After paving a golden pathway of togetherness, ARCASIA celebrated its 50th Anniversary with splendid events including the main scheduled 40th ARCASIA Council Meeting and ARCASIA Forum 20. Inception of hosting ARCASIA Forum 20 initiated in the 38th ARCASIA Council Meeting held in November 2017 in Nepal while Bangladesh became the winner by bidding China.

The whole grand celebration took place in the capital city of Bangladesh, Dhaka during 2-7 November 2019 and was hosted by the Institute of Architects Bangladesh (IAB). The theme of ARCASIA FORUM 20 was "Architecture in a Changing Landscape" in which world-renowned architects from different countries presented their prized knowledge and ideas with a large audience of celebrated architects and younger professionals from home and abroad. A total of 247 foreign architects/delegates and 1245 local architects participated in the Forum 20. This splendid assembly of architects was indeed an occasion to rejuvenate the ties between the regional countries furthermore and continue the legacy of

brotherhood within the member countries of ARCASIA.

As the host of the ARCASIA Forum 20, 23rd Executive Council, IAB, and Ar. Dr. Abu Sayeed M. Ahmed, the Convener of ARCASIA Forum 20 formed 29 Committees to organize one of the biggest international architectural gatherings in Bangladesh. After the formation of the committees, each committee was appointed with one convener and upon their consent, committee conveners were finalized. Conveners were then asked to appoint a member secretary and a list of committee members.

In the 29 different committees, 203 IAB Members volunteered to work for the Forum 20. During the event, more than 121 student volunteers worked alongside the committees.

The ARCASIA Forum 20 comprised of several events throughout the 6-day long Forum. There were three different types of events **A) Formal Events B) Social Events and C) Side Events.**














#### **ARCASIA FORUM 20**

The ARCASIA Forum 20 was held on 3-4 November 2019 at Bangabandhu International Conference Center (BICC), Dhaka. The two-day long Forum was comprised of lecture sessions and exhibitions. Renowned international and local architects discussed their works and experiences in the Forum 20.

Different exhibitions such as exhibition of ARCASIA Award-winning projects, ARCASIA Student Design Competition 2019 shortlisted projects' exhibition, an exhibition by ACSR & ACGSA, exhibition of Aga Khan Award-winning projects and Photography exhibition were organized. As a

parallel event, IAB organized a building material exposition- IAB Build EXPO 2019 in the same venue during the Forum 20.

There were six lecture sessions where six keynote speakers and eight guest speakers were delivered their speeches.






#### HERITAGE WALK AT PANAM NAGAR














#### ARCASIA AWARDS FOR ARCHITECTURE 2019 (AAA 2019) CEREMONY

On the evening of 5 November 2019, the Award Ceremony of ARCASIA Awards for Architecture 2019 (AAA 2019) was held at the Radisson Blu Dhaka Water Garden followed by dinner and a cultural Program. The event was coordinated and moderated by Ar. Mamnoon Murshed Chowdhury, Vice President (National Affairs), IAB, and Ar. Mahmudul Anwar Riyaad was the convener of the AAA 2019.

The aim of the ARCASIA AWARDS FOR ARCHITECTURE (AAA) is to acknowledge exemplary architectural work and in doing so encourage the sustenance of the Asian spirit,

the development and improvement of the Asian built environment and enhancement of the awareness of the role of architects in the socio-economic and cultural life of Asian countries. In this 2019 award cycle, a total of 33 shortlisted projects were given awards in different categories. The submission of projects started on 5 May 2019 and at the deadline, on 17 June 2019, some 424 projects were submitted from 14 countries in 10 categories. On 4 August 2019, in the final session of the two-stage process, the Jury board unanimously selected 33 (thirty-three) projects from 9 (nine) categories as their final

selection, out of which 11 (eleven) had been awarded with gold medals and rests as honorable mentions.

Ar. Farhadur Reza Probal coordinated the event.



































### TOURS










































#### CITY BRANDING AND INSTALLATIONS

### 9TH BERGER AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN ARCHITECTURE 2019 SETS A NEW PARADIGM

The 'Berger Award for Excellence in Architecture' is the second most prestigious professional architectural award of the country besides the IAB Award which is endowed every two years cycle. This Award program was started in 2003 as BERGER Young Architects Award to recognize, honor, and promote outstanding examples of contemporary architecture in Bangladesh and to encourage excellence in architectural practice.

The 9th Berger Award for Excellence in Architecture 2019 was announced by Berger Paints Bangladesh Limited in association with the Institute of Architects Bangladesh on 26 May 2019 through a national daily, websites and, social media. A total number of 100 projects were nominated by the members and finally, 71 projects were submitted on six different categories. As per the submission report, 14 projects were in Single Family Residence, 12 for Multi-family Residence, 6

for Commercial and Mercantile category, 6 for the Green and Sustainable category, 7 for Industrial and, 26 projects in Other categories.

After getting individual primary shortlists from five jurors including a foreign expert, the jury panel came up with a second shortlist and afterward, the panel made their final decision with several site visits and checking out the legal issues like project approvals from the local authority, violations, occupancy type, etc. Finally, the jury panel decided to award only a single project as a commendation in the multi-family residence category. Ar. Mohammad Sharif Uddin Ahammed (A-137), Principal Architect, Sthapotik won the Commendation Award under the multi-family residence category for "The Carnation" project in Dhaka.

The Award Giving Ceremony of '9th Berger Award for Excellence in Architecture 2019' was held on 23 November 2019 at Celebrity Hall, Bashundhara International Conference Center, Agargaon, Dhaka. Award coordinator, Ar. Asif M Ahsanul Haq welcomed the guests at the program. Ms. Rupali Chowdhury, Managing Director of Berger Paints Bangladesh Limited, thanked the prominent architects for their gracious presence and congratulated the winner of the competition in her speech. Architect Jalal Ahmed, President, IAB highlighted the success stories of this initiative to encourage talented architects. Ar. Mustapha Khalid Palash, on behalf of the jury panel, suggests some significant modifications to award criteria. The event ended with a musical program presented by Pintu Ghosh and Friends, followed by dinner.

Renowned architect Khan Md. Mustapha Khalid chaired the jury board, while architect Sheikh Ahsan Ullah Mojumder, Md. Zakiul Islam and artist Wakilur Rahman were the juries this year. Meanwhile, Indian architect Shimul Javeri Kadri served as the foreign juror. The award was coordinated by Ar. Asif M Ahsanul Haq as Award Coordinator while Ar. Joarder Hafiz Ullah was the Deputy Award Coordinator.

The submitted projects were exhibited at the Multi-purpose Hall of IAB Centre from 27 November 2019 till 30 November 2019.













#### CPD ON MEANS OF EGRESS IN TERMS OF LIFE SAFETY

The Continuing Professional Development Workshop on the topic 'Means of Egress' was organized by the Institute of Architects Bangladesh on 19 October 2019 at the Berger Seminar Hall of IAB Centre. Ar. Dewan Shamsul Arif conducted the three and half hour long workshop. Secretary Profession of 23rd Executive Council, IAB Ar. Bayejid Mahbub Khondker coordinated the event.

The first session of the workshop was focused on the classification of buildings according to Bangladesh National Building Code (BNBC) 2006. The detailed overviews to understand the Classification of Buildings based on Occupancy, Occupancy Separation Rating, Fire Zone, and Building Construction Types based on Fire Resistance discussed comprehensively. To achieve minimum requirements for life safety, one of the major items "Means of Egress" was

discussed in detail in second part, which included issues like fire rating, number of exits, placements, capacity and all necessary components of egress.

The CPD program ended with a certification giving ceremony.











#### CPD ON UNIVERSAL ACCESSIBILITY

Bangladesh is one of the fastest developing countries and hence changing its built environment quickly. It is struggling to cope up with these rapid changes in every sector including Facilities/Buildings and their user groups. People with disabilities are part of our social fabric and the Bangladesh government acknowledges inclusive development policies. It is critical to ensure Universal Accessibility for sustainable development. Accessibility is

The workshop covered issues like the general concepts of universal accessibility and awareness, the need to adopt accessibility, how to adopt universal accessibility, building codes and regulations around the world in America, adopting accessibility to existing buildings, and developing the BNBC accessibility chapter in the context of international codes.

Architect Moshfeq Rahman conducted the four-hour-long workshop. Secretary-Profession of 23rd Executive Council, IAB Ar. Bayejid Mahbub Khondker coordinated the event. Mr. Rahman is an Architect, Philanthropist, Activist and member of AIA, LEED, PMP.

# CELEBRATING THE 96TH BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF ARCHITECT MUZHARUL ISLAM

To commemorate the 96th birth anniversary of Sthapattacharja Muzharul Islam a discussion session was organized by the Institute of Architects
Bangladesh on 25 December 2019 at IAB Centre, Dhaka. The title of the discussion was 'Muzharul Islam: Progression of a socially conscious architect struggling with multiple conflicts' [বহুবিধ দক্ষের অভিযাতে মাজহারুল ইসলামঃ একজন সমাজ সচেতন স্থপতির অগ্রযাত্রা]

The keynote speaker of the event was Ar. Nurur Rahman Khan. Ar. Taufiqur Rahman Khan, Seminar & Convention, Secretary, IAB gave an introductory speech.

In 1947, during the volatile post Second World War period British India got divided into a communal line and a unique state named Pakistan emerged in the world map with its two wings, East and West, situated nearly 2000 miles apart from each other. In this context, secular-minded Muzharul Islam engaged himself to express a new national identity through architecture in a land that was created based on religion. He was motivated by socialist ideologies but was educated in the capitalist USA. He was a government employee under an autocratic regime while actively being involved in leftist politics.

For more than a decade Ar.
Nurur Rahman Khan had been in close association with Muzharul Islam. He has taken extensive interviews, documented his work, and has helped to establish the Muzharul Islam Archive. Mr. Khan has completed his doctoral thesis on Islam's works and architectural philosophy.

Ar. Taufiqur Rahman Khan is currently serving as the Secretary, Seminar & Convention, IAB. He is the Member Secretary of Asialoka Trust. He is conducting research independently on the impacts of the Partition of South Asia on different forms of art.

#### IAB SIGNED THE CHARTER OF THE CENTER OF EXCELLENCE IN URBAN DEVELOPMENT

On 23 October 2019, Institute of Architects Bangladesh (IAB) had signed the Charter and By-laws of the Center of Excellence in Urban Development (CUED) as a principal member along with Bangladesh Institute of Planners' (BIP), Institute of Engineers Bangladesh (IEB), and Municipal Association of Bangladesh (MAB). IAB President, Ar. Jalal Ahmed signed the charter on behalf of the IAB Executive Council. Ar. Dr. Farida Nilufar, Secretary, **Environment and Urbanization** participated in the event. Earlier on 23 October 2017, these four organizations along with World Bank had signed the MoU to form this center. The center will

be registered and will start functioning soon as a non-government, non-profitable, non-political, voluntary and charitable organization incorporated under The Societies Registration Act, 1860. It is deemed that CEUD shall contribute to the creation of an enabling environment to help unleash the potential of urbanization to propel Bangladesh into middle-income country status. The principal instruments to be marshaled to support this goal are (a) capacity development and knowledge exchange; (b) research and advocacy; and (c) demand-driven and just-in-time technical assistance. CEUD shall

have three types of membership: Principal Members, Affiliate Members, and Individual Members. Operational Area of CEUD will be throughout Bangladesh and as per decision will open regional centers anywhere in Bangladesh. Through this participation, IAB wishes to contribute directly to the urban development process in Bangladesh and ensure the involvement of architects in this course of action.



### IAB PLACED CONSERVATION-PROPOSAL TO SAVE THE HISTORIC GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE HOSPITAL

IAB placed a detail proposal for conservation to keep the Historic Government Employee Hospital at Fulbaria in use with the newly built Hospital building.

The heritage building was established at Fulbaria as railway hospital during the Second World War but the hospital functions were adapted in a pre -existing building which also existed in 1924's Map of Dhaka city. Due to the newly built multi-storeyed hospital building in the same premises, the old building started to lose its functional importance.

Understanding the possibility of demolition of the heritage building, IAB took part at number of meetings with the 'Dhaka Nagar Unnayan Committee' and placed a detail proposal to ensure a harmony between the old and new structure with focus on the restoration of the heritage building.

Ar. Mubasshar Hussain, Past President, IAB took the initiative through 'Dhaka Nagar Unnayan Committee' to involve IAB in the aforementioned matter. 



OLD BUILDING PRESENTLY USED AS AN EXTENSION OF THE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE HOSPITAL





















## OPEN FORUM ON CONSERVATION OF BUILT HERITAGE IN OLD DHAKA: CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES

An Open Forum on 'Conservation of Built Heritage in Old Dhaka: Challenges and Opportunities' was held on Saturday, 7 December 2019 at the IAB Centre to create a common platform for multi-disciplinary professionals (e.g. Architects, Planners, Archaeologists, Historians, conservation experts, etc.), policymakers, academics, local stakeholders, and representatives of local and international organizations to find a way forward to promote and conserve the built heritage of Old Dhaka through open discussion, dialogue and exchange of opinion.

The Open Forum was a part of the 'Open Heritage Week 2019'

which is an event by the European National Institutes for Culture (EUNIC), Alliance Française de Dhaka, British Council Bangladesh, Goethe-Institut Bangladesh, EU Delegation, Embassy of Spain, Dhaka South City Corporation, Bulbul Academy of Fine Arts and Institute of Architects Bangladesh (IAB) to promote the cultural heritage of Bangladesh.

In the opening speech, Dr. Kirsten Hackenbroch, President, EUNIC Bangladesh gave a brief introduction of the 'Open Heritage Week 2019' with a focus on its objective and the role of the partners.

President of IAB Ar. Jalal Ahmed in his welcome speech

Conservation Architect; Ms. Abeda Aktar, Director-Planning (Joint Secretary), Bangladesh Parjatan Corporation; Mr. Sirajul Islam, Chief Town Planner, Dhaka South City Corporation; Mr. Sazzadur Rasheed, Save the Heritage of Bangladesh; Ms. Lovely Yesmin, Deputy Director, Department of Archaeology Bangladesh; Prof. Dr. Mozammel Hoque, Department of Archaeology, Jahangir Nagar University and Mr. Ashraful Islam, Project Director, DAP, RAJUK. The panel discussion mostly covered the role of the respective organizations in the heritage sector with a focus on the existing challenges and opportunities.

Farhana Nizam Chowdhury, Programme Assistant, Goethe-Institut Bangladesh; A.S.M Ismail, Former Chief Architect, Ministry of Housing and Public works, GOB; Archaeologist Nurul Kabir, Associate Professor, Department of Archaeology, JU; Md. Sohel

Rana, Urban Development Specialist, UNHABITAT; Eliza Binte Elahi, academic and travel writer; Advocate Mustafizur Rahman, SHB; Ar. Afrina Islam, Dhaka fiction and Ar. Tasnova Iqbal raised different issues related to heritage conservation in old Dhaka.

Ar. Mohammad Sazzad Hossain, Secretary, Heritage & Culture, IAB in his closing speech summarized the overall discussion with a focus on the rapid transformation of the old fabric without considering the value defining attributes, lack of comprehensive policy for development, existing gaps in heritage listing, lack of coordination among actors and stakeholders, lack of facilities for heritage tourism, etc. As a way forward, Ar. Hossain also emphasized on scopes in the revised DAP, adaptation of Transferable Development Right (TDR), preparation of more credible and inclusive policy for heritage listing, facilitation of heritage tourism, bridging the gap among actors and stakeholders, capacity building and raising awareness.
