**1.0 Brief History**

Institute of Architects Bangladesh (IAB) was established on February 25<sup>th</sup>, 1972 in Dhaka, immediately after the independence of Bangladesh in 1971. The Institute of Architects Bangladesh is a professional institution to safe guard, promote and develop the profession of architecture in Bangladesh. The members of the Institute of Architects are morally bound to practice the profession according to rules, regulation and ethics established by the IAB. It has the mandate of its members to represent them as the supreme authority to deal with any matter related to the profession of architecture in Bangladesh. The Institute is run by a fifteen-member Executive Council that the members elect for a two-year term.

**3.1 Membership**

There are mainly 2 categories of membership, namely General Membership and Honorary Membership. Fellow, Member, Associate Member and Student Member are the parts of General Membership. Honorary Fellow and Honorary Member are the parts of Honorary Membership. Only Fellows and Members have voting rights.

A Member pays a yearly subscription of Taka 2,000.00 (USD-25) Approx. only.

### 4.0 Budget

**Funds of IAB are raised from the following sources: -**

- (a) Admission Fees and Annual Subscription of the members.
- (b) Fund raising activities such as building material exhibition, publications etc.
- (c) Financial Grant from the Government through the Ministry of Housing and Public Works.

Every year the Treasurer of the Institute prepares a budget, which the Executive Council approves. The Treasurer is also responsible for preparation of the audited accounts (Income and Expenditure) and the Balance Sheets, which are approved by the Executive Council before presentation at the Annual General Meeting.

### 5.0 Number of Chapters, Centers

According to the Constitution, Institute can establish Chapter from time to time in different regions of Bangladesh, where the number of members and fellows are at least 25. The constitution also has the provision for formation of Centers of IAB at different parts of Bangladesh, where the number of members and fellows are between 10 and 25. At present IAB has one chapter in Chittagong and three Centers in Khulna, Sylhet and Rajshahi. The Executive Council formulates rules and regulation for operation of the Chapter and Centers as per the Constitution of IAB. The Chapter, Centers operate through sub-committee accountable to the Executive Council of the Institute.

### 6.0 AGM/ Bi-AGM

As per the constitution of IAB, Annual General Meeting (AGM) is held in every year by the 1<sup>st</sup> week of December to consider and adopt the yearly accounts and balance sheet and the general reports.

The Biennial General Meeting (BGM) is also held in the 1<sup>st</sup> week of December in every second year of the running executive council to consider and adopt the yearly accounts and balance sheet and the general reports of the Executive Council. Election of the subsequent Executive Council is held as last agenda of this meeting. As and when necessary, Extra-ordinary General Meetings are convened to transact any specific or urgent business. the last Bi-AGM was held on **December 2020**. The Biennial General Meeting and Election for the next Executive Council will be held in the last week of **December 2022**.

## 7.0 Legal Status of the Institute

The institute is registered with the Government as a Society under provision of law and hence IAB has a legal basis in the Country.

The Government of Bangladesh recognizes the Institute (IAB) as the only organization to represent Architects of the Country. The members of the Institute are morally bound to practice the profession according to the rules, regulations and ethics IAB establishes. The Institute has mandate of its members to represent itself as the supreme authority to deal with any matter related to the profession of Architecture in Bangladesh.



The fruitful meeting had begun with elaborating the importance of the TSC complex as an architectural edifice as well as a historic premise. Elaborate alternate options were presented on screen by the team. Prof. Dr. Md. Akhtaruzzaman, VC of Dhaka University gave his patience hearing and expressed his solidarity towards the alternatives proposed by IAB delegates.

While the IAB delegates reiterated on an open architectural design competition for such a challenging and prestigious intervention, the Vice Chancellor indicated that the project has been undertaken by the Ministry of Public Works & Housing and they have to be convinced to do so. **Project Description:** Bamboo Playspace is a temporary pavilion collaboratively designed for inclusive community building, for play, performances of theatre and dance, and a beautiful social gathering place for women and their children. Designed and built as part of Paraa's radical new design course, CADSE, with Bamboo artisans, the children of LEEDO Peace Home and architecture students from Dhaka. A major impact has been bringing together the vulnerable children from the Peace Home, with their local neighbourhood children.

**Date Completed:** 03/04/2019




The need to play is inherent in all of us, and even more prominently in children, of all ages, genders and abilities. Dhaka is the capital of Bangladesh, a sprawling dense metropolis of over 23 million people and under enormous strain to provide adequate quality of parks and play spaces. This particular project is unusual in its design and development, and will act as a precedent for much more radical, collaborative design projects in the future. The site of the Bamboo Playspace is in Warpur Garden, CoU, on the west side of the Buriganga River.

Paraa's radical design course, CADSE, Critical Architecture, Design, and Sustainable Environments was borne out of the immediacy to address the need for additional critical design education and participation in the built environment through practical hands-on projects; the course is accredited in partnership with independent University Bangladesh's School of Life Sciences. The fundamental aspect of this course is that the students have to work with a community to resolve a space design challenge, learning about land access, materials, space-making, environment, and the ethics and politics related to creating socially just spaces.

Paraa has worked closely with LEEDO, a grassroots children's charity, who run a home, and also focus on caring trafficked children in Dhaka and elsewhere. Their home houses 50+ children, many of whom are differently abled, and from 2 years old to 18+, and of mixed gender.

The charity secured land adjacent to its Peace Home for three years. CADSE students were involved in formulating the program for the space with the children of LEEDO Peace Home, using participatory methods learned in the classroom. The program was then turned into a competition, with over 23 groups participating. The children of the Home chose 2 designs; these two groups along with the CADSE students, were mentored and supported to finalise the design, resolving technical aspects. This was then built in collaboration with a team of Bamboo artisans.

The playspace offers a central open space, where children can play or organize festivals and performances. The whole structure can accommodate around 200 people at three different levels. Specific features designed to include therapeutic exercises for differently abled children.

Younger children can engage in suitable play features, like swings, hanging rope-bridge, etc., in a safe place with slatted 'super-room', while older children find themselves in a more adventurous zone of climbing wall and the spider web. The semi-shaded decks of the playspace can host different sorts of workshops or hang-outs of people of the different age groups of the local neighbourhood.

For the opening of the space, Paraa curated and commissioned a children's theatre production for a half-day festival of arts and culture and meeting designers, therapists, fine artists, musicians, and others, to explore ways they can interact with people and the structure. 'SAND KINLEY' (LIVE!) play was held to demonstrate the potential of the Bamboo space and the importance of the creative arts for robust human development.

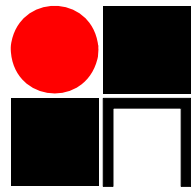
